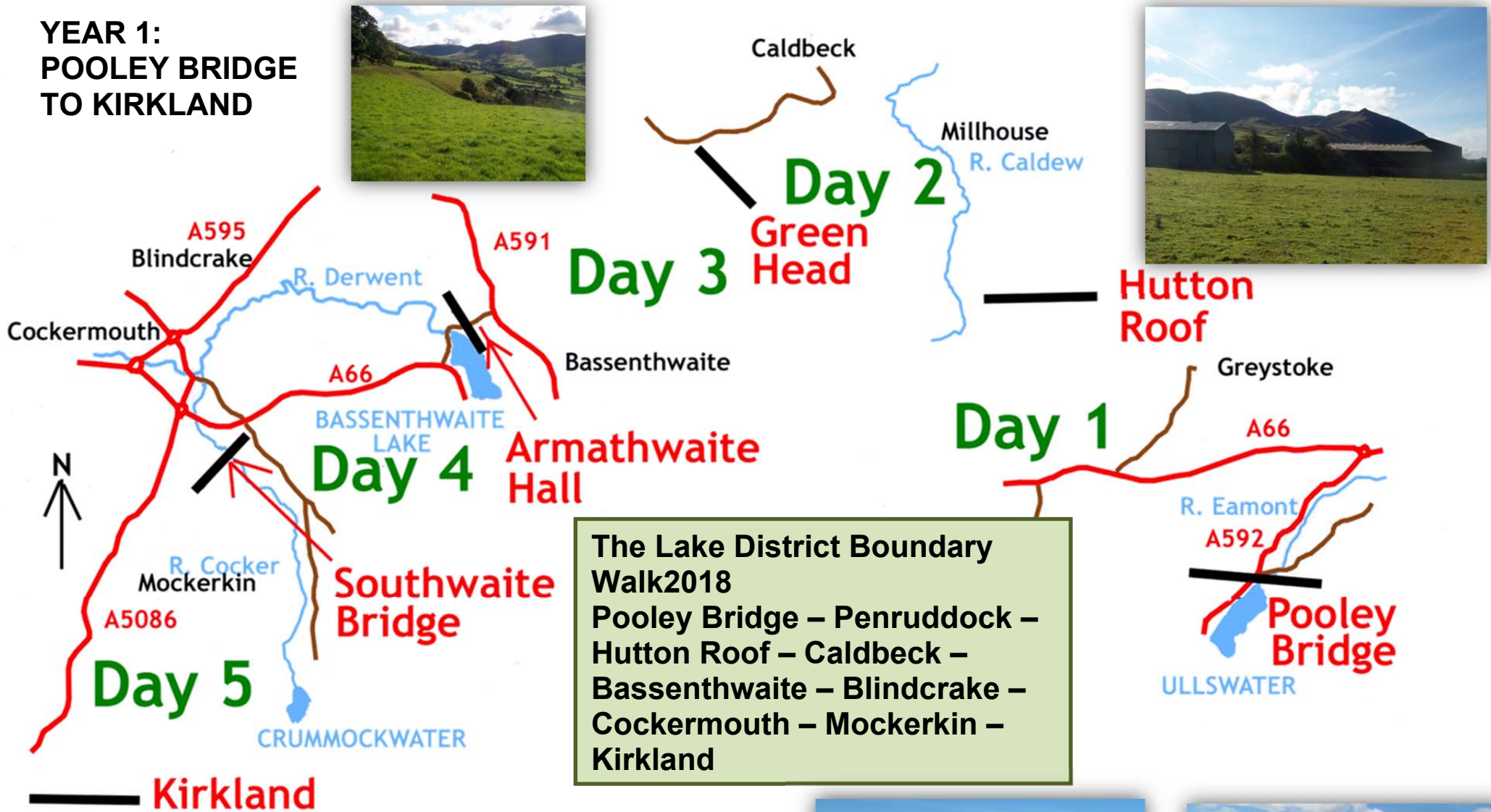

The Lake District Boundary Walk: Walk Arrangements for Summer 2018

During June and July the Northern section of Graham Dugdale's 'Lake District Boundary Walk' is to be walked on five separate Sundays. The walk, published in 1996, is to be tackled through a three year programme around the boundary of the Lake District in an anti-clockwise direction. Each walk will be linear and between 9 and 10 miles in length.

Walk 1 will begin in Pooley Bridge and progress north-westwards via Dacre, Penruddock and Berrier to Hutton Roof. **Walk 2** will continue northwards through Caldbeck and along the northern fringe of the fells to the hamlet of Fellside. **Walk 3** will continue westwards, passing by Little Cockup then through Orthwaite to Bassenthwaite Village and Lake: to finish at Armathwaite Hall. **Walk 4** progresses further westwards along the Derwent Valley to Isel, Redmain and then Cockermouth. The walk finishes at Southwaite Bridge in the Cocker Valley. **Walk 5** proceeds southwards through Sosgill, Mockerkin and Lamplugh to finish in Kirkland village.

The standard for each walk is of the Moderate Grade which hopefully will appeal to members from across our walking groups who'd like a socially relaxed away day in good company. More strenuous options could be made available on some of the days, subject to offers of leadership. Walking boots and warm, waterproof clothing are essential, along with all other equipment and food for a day's walk.

At the start of a walk day we will meet up at Penrith Rugby Club car park at 8.45 am. A coach will then transfer us to the start point for the walk. Each of the walks is to be pre booked and will be limited to the numbers that can be accommodated on the coach. There will be a charge of £10 per person for each day to defray the coach costs. This will be collected on the day of each walk.
